



PARENTAL PERMISSION

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Your child has expressed a desire to serve as a KC Ambassador for the National Keratoconus Foundation. This is a volunteer position with a one-year commitment.

The expectation is that KC Ambassadors donate at least 50 hours during the course of the year to increasing public awareness of keratoconus in their community. Our Ambassadors are either living with keratoconus, or have a close friend or family member with the condition.

NKCF will provide your child with information and materials that will be helpful in telling the story. We will also provide ideas for activities that will help them achieve their goal of 50 hours of community service. There is no expectation that KC Ambassadors fundraise on behalf of NKCF, but your child may choose to participate in a local charity fundraiser (e.g., 10K races) as a team member for NKCF.

We do ask that all KC Ambassadors share a photo that we will use on our website. We will use first names and hometowns to identify our KC Ambassadors, but will not include last names or other identifiable information on any of our sites available to the public.

Social media is an important communication vehicle today, and we encourage KC Ambassadors include stories about living with KC in their social media accounts. The extent to which they can share stories is a decision made by you at the family level.

During the year, your child may participate in activities as a KC Ambassador. If pictures are shared with us or posted on social media, we will assume you have given permission to use these photos to promote keratoconus awareness and the KC Ambassador program.
